

MA 122 – Fall 2012 (2012F2)
Grade Distribution and Grade Scale

Grading: The components of the course will be weighted as follows:

Exams (3)	70%
Written Homework (4)	10%
WebEx Assignments – WebAssign (11)	10%
Gateway Assessments – WebAssign (2)	5%
Participation – Workshop & Lecture	5%

The WebEx will be graded simply as an accumulation of all the assigned WebEx exercises. Typically each exercise will be worth 10 points. The final score will be the total points accumulated divided by the maximum available points.

The Gateway Assessments are graded as Pass/Fail with 80% as the passing mark. There is no partial credit for these assessments but you are given up to three attempts to pass. There are two gate assessments, each scheduled to serve as a review of the routine exercises prior to an exam. Passing both gates will count 5 points toward the final grade; passing only one of the two gates will count 3 points.

The Participation grade will be based on attendance and active participation in workshops and lectures. The use of clickers in the lecture periods may be used to determine participation in lectures. It is important that students remember to bring the clicker to every lecture class.
